Article from a print newspaper (authors)

In-text referencing

Direct quote

"the succession of leaders... since the election" (Brett, 2009, p. 6).

Paraphrasing

Brett (2009, p. 6) compares the liberals in opposition after Fraser with the post Howard era.

Reference List

Author, Initial/s. (year of publication) 'Article title', Newspaper Title, day and Month of issue, p./pp. page number/s.

Brett, J. (2009) 'Libs risk becoming a down-market protest party', The Age, 5 December, p. 6.

Notes

- If there is more than one author follow the examples for a journal article with multiple authors.
- Newspaper headline is the article title in single quotes.
- Newspaper title is in italics.
- Include the date of issue (day and Month) of the newspaper after the title.
- Include the page number of the article.

Article from a print newspaper (no authors)

In-text referencing

Direct quote

"A British Ministry of Defence spokesman confirmed..." (*Australian*, 12 November 2010, p. 14).

Paraphrasing

The report in the Australian (12 November 2010, p. 14) stated that Breaker Morant... .

Reference List

Title of Newspaper (year of publication) 'Article Title', day and Month of issue, p./pp. page number/s.

Australian (2010) 'Breaker Morant', 12 November, p. 14.

Notes

- If the author is not evident use Title of Newspaper
- Include the date of issue (day and Month) of the newspaper after the title.
- Include the page number of the article.

Article from the internet

In-text referencing

Direct auote

"China, for instance, is targeting ... over 15 years" (Gittens 2010).

Paraphrasing

Gittens (2010) accuses Australia of being behind other countries efforts to reduce carbon.

Reference List

Author, Initial/s. (year of publication) 'Article title', Newspaper Title, day and Month. Available at: URL (accessed date: date).

Gittins, R. (2010) 'Suits us to be deluded on climate', *The Age*, 17 November. Available at: http://www.theage.com.au/environment/climate-change/suits-us-to-be-deluded-on-climate-20101117-17wyp.html (Accessed: 6 December 2014).

Use the same examples for either Article from a print newspaper with author/s or no authors.

Notes

- Reference a newspaper article from a database, e.g. Factiva or ProQuest, in exactly the same way as you would a newspaper article in print.
- There is no need to acknowledge which database the article came from.
